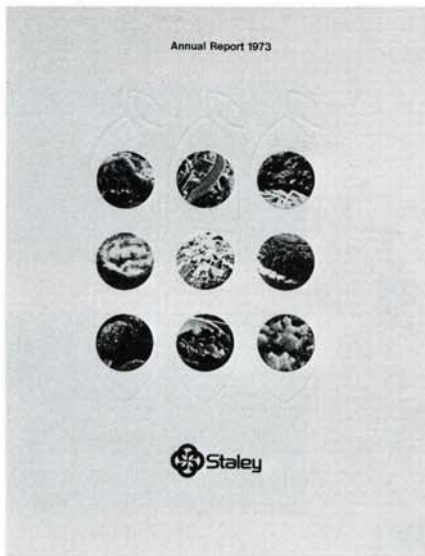


Blake & Weiss

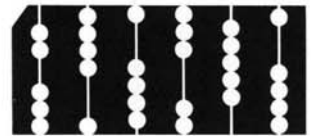

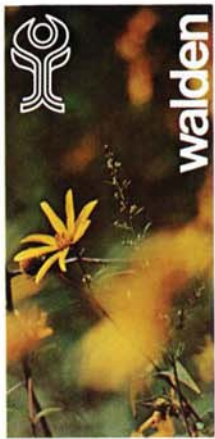

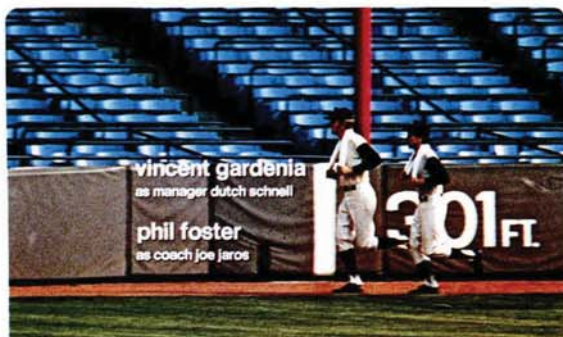
